We've already started prepping for the 2020 Scholarship Program that starts January 1st. If you know someone that would make an excellent candidate, please spread the word – deadline is February 28th.

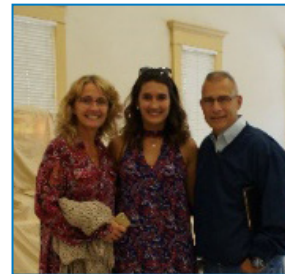
We hope you enjoy this edition of the Newsletter. I'd like to thank everyone who contributed. We truly enjoy hearing about what you've been up to.

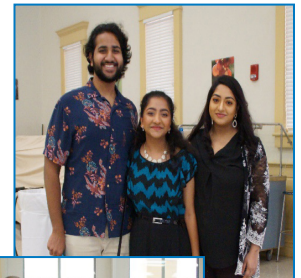

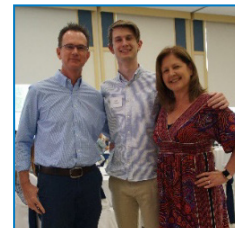

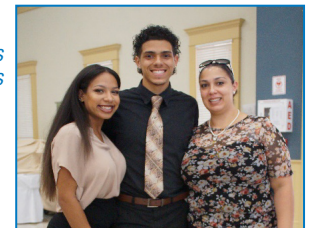

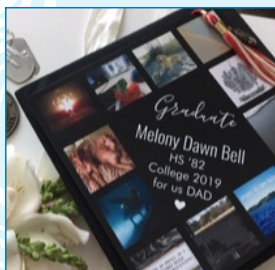

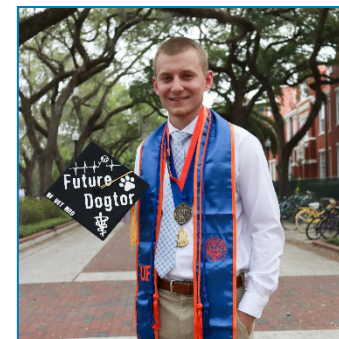


Glisson, Michael: celebrated his 70th birthday with family and friends at Coppertail Brewery. Michael has been a scholarship evaluator for over 15 years.

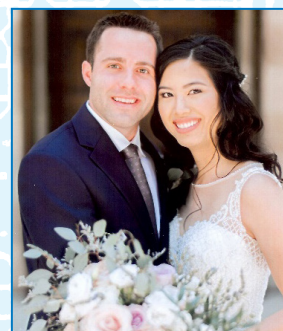

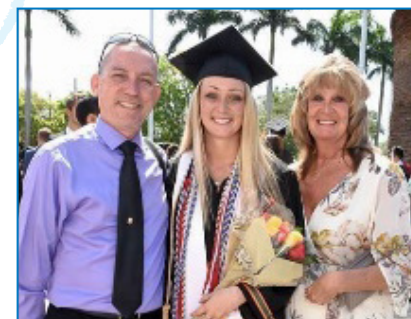

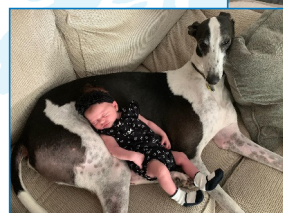

Eloise at 1 week old

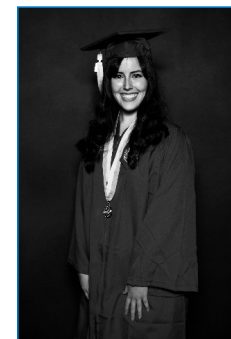

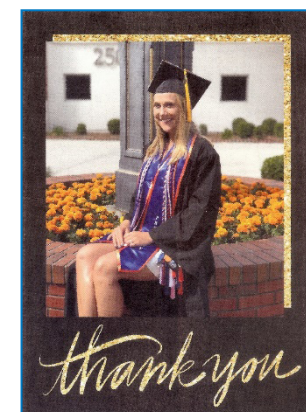

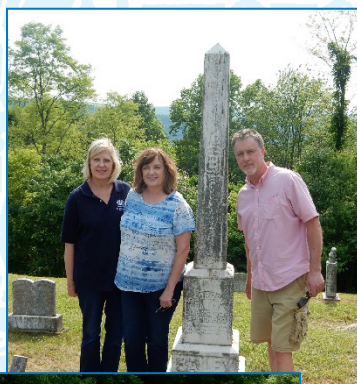
