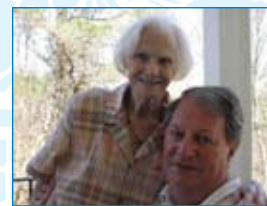

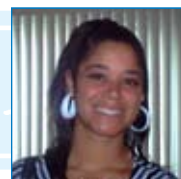

We enjoyed last year's Christmas cruise so much, we decided to do it again. This year's cruise was even bigger and better!

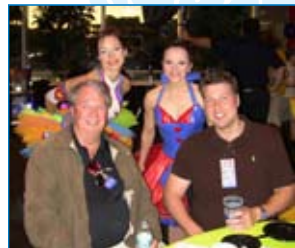

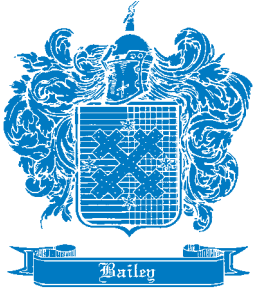
