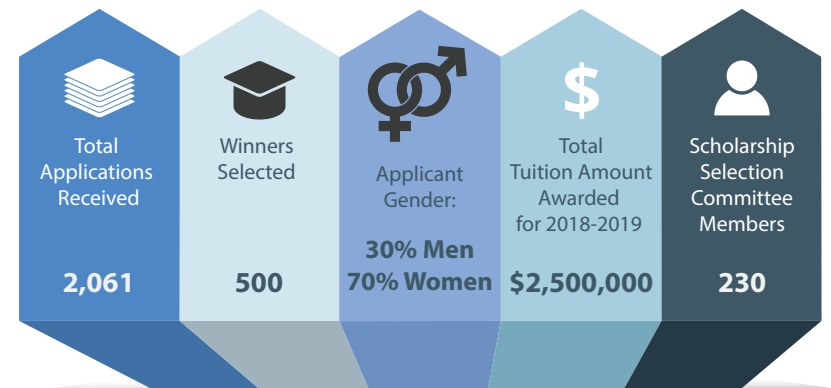

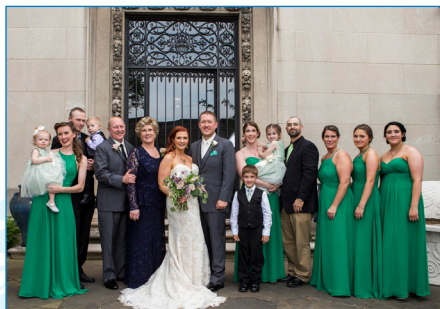

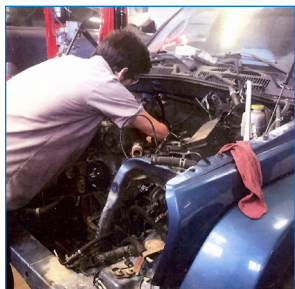
Blankenship, Joanne: married Shawn Altaffer in May 2017 in Cleveland, Ohio. The couple spent their honeymoon in Thailand.

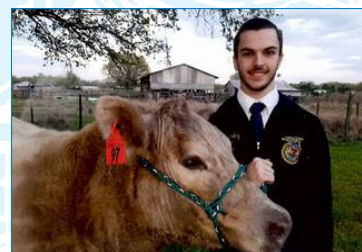
Disney on Ice
